BIOGRAPHY:

Annya Sand (b. 1983) was born in Central Asia and currently lives and works in London. A self-taught artist, Sand began painting at a young age. Specialising mainly in oil painting, Sand's art is deeply influenced by her childhood memories, growing up in Kazakhstan and being exposed to the rich variety of Central Asian and Russian cultures. Her artworks are predominantly abstract in style and characterised by earthy tones and harmonious colours. Sand considers herself an international artist, as she draws inspiration from different cultures and the world around her, exploring the complexity and mystery of human nature.

Sand's works are exhibited in museums, galleries and private collections worldwide. Her works have been showcased at the Kyrgyz National Museum of Fine Arts, the Kasteev State Museum of Arts (the National museum) in Kazakhstan, and at the Art Gallery of Uzbekistan in Tashkent. She takes part in numerous art fairs and exhibitions around the world.

Annya Sand is a dedicated supporter of charities that assist children and women. Over the years, she has raised thousands of pounds for The Children's Burns Trust. In 2012 she exhibited at the Saatchi Gallery during the Arts for India Diwali Celebration and Exhibition, and raised funds for The Arts for India charity. She is currently supporting the Great Ormond Street Hospital Children's Charity, the Mayor's Fund for London and Caspian Art Foundation. Sand has donated her artworks to all of these organisations.
